The People's Assembly National Demonstration in London took place on Saturday 26th June 2021. Salisbury Campaign for Nuclear Disarmament staged a local action in support of National CND's 'Nurses not Nukes' bloc within the march to show that, after the pandemic, we want a new normal, free from the scourge of nuclear weapons.

Salisbury CND condemns the government's decision to increase the UK nuclear warhead stockpile by 40% during a national pandemic, while refusing to award the very brave nurses who cared for the country an adequate pay-rise.

Mr Johnson's declaration to raise the number of UK nuclear warheads breaks the UN Nuclear Non-Proliferation Treaty, signed by the UK, and thereby risks a new arms race. The Treaty is crucial in persuading other states not to develop nuclear weapons of their own.

Salisbury CND says spending public money on weapons of mass destruction instead of doctors, nurses and hospitals must be opposed.
