

CND calls for “Nurses not Nukes”

The CND’s ‘Nurses not Nukes’ group in the People’s Assembly National Demonstration were in London on Saturday, June 26, they were supported by the Salisbury campaign group.

“Salisbury Campaign for Nuclear Disarmament staged a local action in support of the national movement within the march to show that, after the pandemic, we want a new normal, free from the scourge of nuclear weapons,” said one of the organisers.

Salisbury CND condemns the government’s decision to increase the UK nuclear warhead stockpile by 40% during a national pandemic, but refusing to award the very brave nurses who cared for the country an adequate pay-rise. Spending public money on weapons of mass destruction instead of doctors, nurses and hospitals must be opposed.
