Salisbury Campaign for Nuclear disarmament today joined with Southampton CND and others from the Stop the War Coalition to express their absolute opposition to the war in Ukraine and their solidarity with all those calling for peace around the world. Today was a global day of action, with protests planned in many countries. The gathering at Bargate, Southampton, was part of that global movement.

The protest expressed absolute opposition to Russia's invasion of Ukraine. The inhumanity of war had moved those attending to express their solidarity with the people of Ukraine and those anti-war protesters in Russia.

A spokesperson for Salisbury CND said "our hearts go out to those whose lives have been torn apart by the brutality of war. The solution to this must lie with negotiation rather than military action. We urge all those who are able to promote such talks to give all their energy to finding a negotiated solution."
