UPCOMING EVENTS

HIROSHIMA and NAGASAKI COMMEMORATIVE CANDLE FLOAT - MONDAY 8TH AUGUST,
starts 8.45pm - on the River Avon,
from FISHERTON STREET BRIDGE to CRANE STREET, SP1 2ND



After 2 years of Covid 19 restrictions, Salisbury CND is staging our annual floating of 200 lanterns on the River Avon in remembrance of the Japanese victims of the nuclear bombs dropped on Hiroshima and Nagasaki in 1945, and for all victims of nuclear weapons.

This year, we will be incorporating lanterns decorated by Japanese school children that have been generously sent to us from Hiroshima, along with a letter from the Mayor of Hiroshima, who is a member of the Mayors for Peace movement against nuclear weapons.

Since February this year, we are faced with the very frightening reality that a nuclear exchange could happen in the current war in Ukraine, which adds an urgency to our campaigning against nuclear weapons and lobbying our government to sign the UN Treaty on the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons.

Bruce Kent

Bruce Kent, who has died aged 92, was a prophetic and charismatic figure. To see Monsignor Kent conducting a service of exorcism at the Polaris nuclear submarine base at Faslane on the west coast of Scotland, or supporting protests at Greenham Common, Berkshire, against the deployment of US cruise missiles, or allowing bailiffs to seize his few worldly possessions rather than pay with his taxes for the proliferation of nuclear weapons was a important inspiration to us all.

The formation of Salisbury CND was inspired by a talk given locally by Bruce in 1981.

We shall all miss him greatly.
