Second Gaza Ceasefire Candle Light Vigil Salisbury, Saturday 2nd December 2023

On Saturday afternoon, there was a second candle light vigil in Salisbury calling for a permanent ceasefire in Gaza, Israel and the West Bank. It was organised by Salisbury Campaign for Nuclear Disarmament, taking part in a nationwide campaign, together with Sarum Concern for Israel and Palestine. Double the number of people joined this second vigil, with a wide range of citizens committed to peace.

A spokesperson for Salisbury CND said "With the resumption of the devastating attack on civilians in Gaza, we cannot stand silently by. There is no military solution to this awful situation and the sooner the violence on both sides is halted and talks begin, the better. Our government is complicit in supplying the weapons and logistic support that feed into the destruction in Gaza and we demand that our politicians take note of the majority opinion in this country, which does not support this war"

There will be a further national protest in London next Saturday 9th December and a further candle light vigil in Salisbury on Saturday 16th December at 4:15 - 4:45pm.
