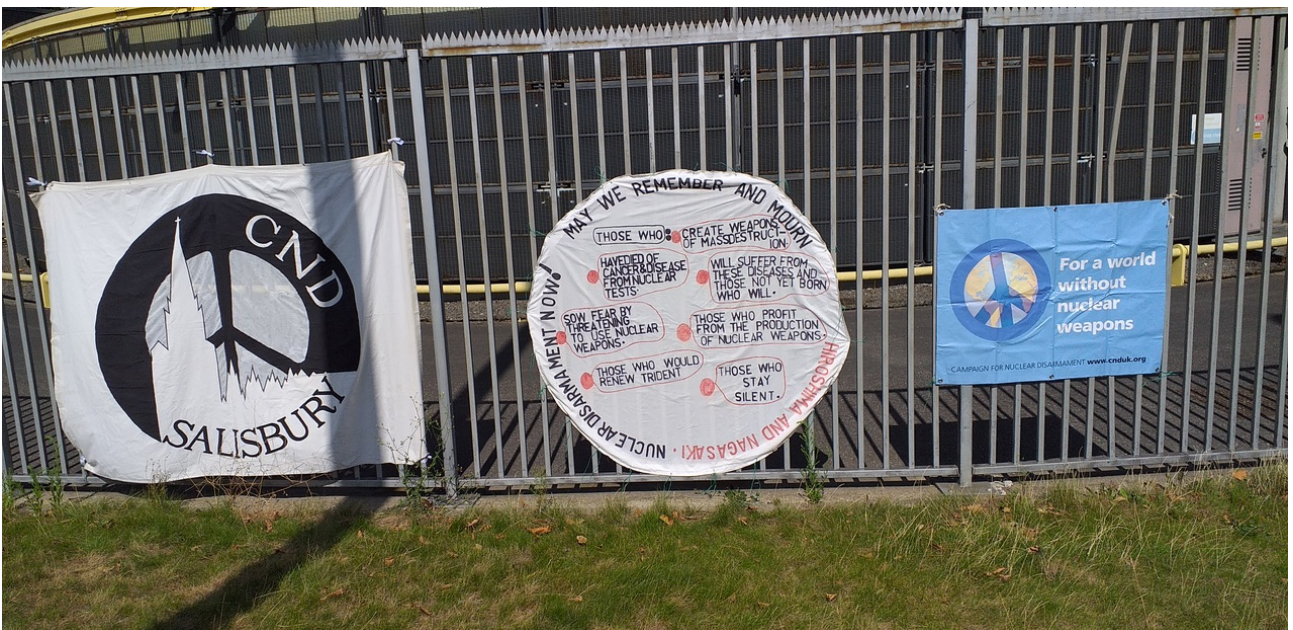


27 July
